Dear Level II Candidate,

I am writing to you to invite you to attend the New Zealand Cricket Level II course in 2011.

The course usually runs from June till September but final presentation dates and venues have not yet been confirmed. These will be communicated to you upon your registration of interest in attending the course.

The demands of this course are substantial in terms of the time and effort required by aspirant Level II candidates. A list of the modules to be completed appears with this letter to you and there is a list of the assessments that are required to be completed following the course.

The workbook needs to be completed and handed back to the Coaching Director as these books are independently assessed by New Zealand cricket nominated assessors. You will be informed at the commencement of the course when these workbooks are due.

You will also be required to arrange a time to have your practical coaching assessment with the course supervisor. This is your responsibility and you will need to be actively coaching a team to ensure this section of your assessment proves meaningful.

The cost of this Level II course is \$250.00 to cover the cost of the resources, the presentations and other costs associated with running such a course.

Payments being made on behalf of a learner coach by a junior club, school or college need to be negotiated with the Club Convenor and Treasurer prior to attendance at the course. They are also required to sign the registration form to indicate the clubs willingness to pay for the coach to attend the course

Cricket Wellington will generate and invoice for this amount to be posted to club convenors or treasurer upon receipt of the completed registration form.

If you are making a personal payment then this payment is to be made on the morning of the first day of the course.

NZC Level II course Content and Outcomes

*Please note that the timing of the presentations is only an approximation. Sessions can be longer than set out below

Batting Module – 6 Hours* - 2 x 3hr sessions

Outcomes

- Understand and explain the positives and negative aspects of different set ups
- Understand and explain the concept of pre delivery- movements
- Demonstrate and explain the correct technique of the skills covered
- Understand when to use each of the batting shots and how they can be used to effectively to manipulate the game
- Demonstrate an understanding of a variety of batting drills
- Understand, explain and demonstrate the correct bouncer evasion techniques
- Understand explain and demonstrate the principles of playing spin bowling
- Understand the advanced aspects of running between the wickets
- Understand, explain and implement classroom sessions to develop batting game sense

Spin Bowling Module – 4 Hours* 2 x 2 hour sessions

Outcomes

- Understand and explain the relationship between the coach, spin bowler, captain and keeper
- Understand, explain and demonstrate the different variations of off spin and leg spin bowling
- Understand and demonstrate the progressions of teaching the off and leg spin variations
- Understand the key observation points
- Through performance analysis be able to understand, explain and identify and rectify issues that may effect the development of spin bowlers
- Understand and explain important tactical aspects of spin bowling
- Understand the importance of developing a bowler's game sense in the classroom.

Pace Bowling Module– 4 Hours* 2 x 2 hr sessions

Outcomes

- Understand the 7 patterns of movement of pace bowling
- Understand, explain and demonstrate the pace bowling deliveries
- Understand the role of the pace bowler
- Understand and explain the fundamentals of developing a run up
- Understand and demonstrate the different slower ball deliveries
- Understand and explain the important aspects of the bouncer
- Understand and explain the pace bowlers tactics with regards to using the crease
- Understand and explain swing theory
- Understand and explain pace bowler injury prevention

Fielding Module – 3 Hours* 1 x 3 hr session

Outcomes

- Understand and implement a basic throwing programme
- Understand and demonstrate basic throwing techniques
- Understand and explain the important aspects of the specific fielding positions
- Understand, explain and demonstrate important catching techniques for the different positions
- Understand, explain and demonstrate ground fielding techniques
- Understand, explain and demonstrate the 'wedge' backing up technique

Wicket Keeping – 3 Hours* 1 x 3 hr session

Outcomes

- Understand the relationship between the keeper and the coach
- Understand the role of the keeper in all versions of the game
- Understand what to look for when identifying a potential keeper
- Understand, explain and demonstrate advanced keeping techniques
- Understand and demonstrate a variety of keeping drills
- Understand the importance of developing mental skills for the keeper
- Understand the principles of performance analysis
- Understand the principles of key performance Indicators

NZC Level II Generic Modules

Coaching Philosophy – 3hrs* 1 x 3hr session

Outcomes

- Identify your coaching philosophy
- Understand your motives for coaching
- Develop your coaching goals
- Develop your understanding of what quality coaching looks like
- Identify your values as a coach

Planning – 3hrs* 1 x 3hr session

Outcomes

- Develop an understanding of why planning is important and what is important for successful planning
- Understand how to develop a direction for your team and a team culture
- Develop the competency to carry out a thorough analysis of your teams current situation
- Develop a method to plan your teams vision
- Develop skills and processes to review your plans

Coaching Process – 2hrs* 1 x 2hr session

Outcomes

- Develop an awareness of your own coaching
- Develop an understanding of skill acquisition theory
- Develop your communication skills
- Develop your feedback skills
- Develop effective questioning skills

Mental Skills – 2hrs* 1 x 2hr session

Outcome

- Develop the ability to integrate sport psychology into your coaching to assist your athletes in attaining peak performance.

3. Fielding – 8 Techniques
4. Keeping - 4 Techniques
