OBJECTIVES	To organise and run a series of activity sessions including skills drills and games for 5-8 year olds	To organise and run a game of MILO Kiwi Cricket including understanding the requirements, rules, umpiring and scoring, and to reinforce skill development	To learn how and what to coach a team playing and practising the conventional 11-a-side game	To understand the planning process, coach skills through the principles of biomechanics, and demonstrate an understanding of effective team coaching and the game	To undertake detailed planning and evaluation, understanding and using the principles of biomechanics to coach, analyse and improve skills, and demonstrate an understanding of the coaching process and effective team coaching, including game tactics	To expand coach capabilities in relation to the coaching process, self development, leadership, and planning and management, and develop an in-depth knowledge and understanding of skill acquisition, coaching these skills, and LTAD
